Yeah!!! We are reopening to participants this week. It looks like the Covid infections are dropping, but we have reservations. Please weigh your options before returning to the Center. We know you want to socialize, exercise, and see your friends. Although we did our best to give everyone the opportunity to get their vaccines and booster, not all of our participants took advantage of the availability and some of our participants are not eligible for vaccines due to their health situations. As we have stressed, unvaccinated individuals have a far greater chance of infection, hospitalization and death. They also spread the virus at a greater rate than vaccinated individuals. The Omicron variant is highly contagious. We cannot guarantee your safety, no one can. We can only ask that you consider your health situation before returning. **DO NOT ENTER THE CENTER** if you have cold symptoms, sore throat, cough, sneezing, runny nose, aches, fever or stomach upset! Everyone entering the Center is required to wear a mask, N95 or KN 95 have been proven to be best at preventing the spread, and are available in pharmacies and grocery stores. Our exercise classes will be **both in-person and live on zoom**, and we are adding more zoom programs next month.

The Chester County Health Department cancelled the last vaccine clinic at the Senior Center on Tuesday, January 25th. They will accommodate those who registered.
