Please call 610-935-1515 x 24 and leave a message for Cari who will return your call to schedule 2 drive thru appointments. Unlike last year when the center was closed, the center is open for activities. We encourage everyone to comply with the following:

1. **Please proceed slowly through our parking lots.** Tax preparers and Seniors attending activities are in the lots!
2. Parking on the firehouse side of the building is for **taxes only**. If you arrive for a tax appointment, please park in the assigned space, numbered 1-5 on the sign in front of the space. Please do not arrive early, your spot may be occupied. But don't be late either, it throws off all the other scheduled appointments.
3. All participants joining us **for activities** should enter the parking lot on the **Clinic side of the building**. Tax preparers will be moving from the cars in the parking lot to the door in the rear of the building on the firehouse side. Their safety is our priority and our combined responsibility. Please drive cautiously!
4. Most of our participants have handicapped parking permits, but we have a limited number of spaces. Please keep those spaces open for those using walkers, wheelchairs, or have limited mobility. They appreciate your kindness!

Please understand we are doing our best to keep you safe! Get your vaccine and booster. **DO NOT ENTER THE CENTER** if you have cold symptoms, sore throat, cough, sneezing, runny nose, aches, fever, stomach upset or were exposed to someone with Covid! Everyone entering the Center is required to wear a N95 or KN 95 mask, which we will provide at the Center once a week.
